MOTION WAS MADE BY RANDY TRICOU TO ACCEPT THE APRIL 15, 2019 MEETING MINUTES **SECONDED** BY B.J. COUVILLION AND MOTION **PASSED ALL IN FAVOR; NO NAYS**

GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT---JASON HOOD

JASON HOOD ADVISED THE BOARD THAT SEWERAGE DISTRICT ISSUED (100) ONE-HUNDRED PERMITS FOR APRIL, AND THAT (7) SEVEN OF THOSE ARE NEW ADDRESSES FOR THE MONTH.

MR. HOOD STATED THAT THE MODAD COMMITTEE MET AT THE BEGINNING OF MAY AND THAT OPTIONS WERE DISCUSSED WITH COUNCILMAN DAVID VIAL ON THE BEST ROUTE TO ENCOURAGE MODAD TO EXIT TANGIPAHOA PARISH. MR. VIAL AGREED TO RESEARCH OTHER PARISHES' EFFORTS TO REMOVE PRIVATE WASTEWATER COMPANIES FROM THEIR BOUNDARIES, AND ANY LITIGATION THAT AROSE FROM THOSE EFFORTS. MR. HOOD FURTHER STATED, THAT AT THIS POINT, THERE IS STILL A LOT OF RESEARCH TO BE DONE AND HE HAS REQUESTED THAT THE PARISH START EXPLORING THE POSSIBILITY OF CREATING AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE THAT THE SEWAGE GENERATED BY SINGLE FAMILY DEVELOPMENTS OF (50) FIFTY OR MORE BE OPERATED AND TREATED BY THE T.P.S.D.#1.

JASON HOOD ADVISED THE BOARD THAT PARISH GOVERNMENT HAS SELECTED A GRANTS ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE L.C.D.B.G. VELMA EXPANSION PROJECT, AND SPANGLER ENGINEERING IS CURRENTLY WORKING A BUDGET FOR THE POSSIBLE EXPANSION, THAT IF APPROVED, WOULD BE FUNDED 100% BY GRANT FUNDS. MR. HOOD STATED THAT HE WILL KEEP THE BOARD MEMBERS UPDATED ON THE PROGRESS OF THAT PROCESS.
