Mr. Hood stated that the pictures provided shows how close to completion for the Bedico Treatment Facility access road off of Dusty Lane.

June 4<sup>th</sup> Brian Shirey, Chuck Spangler, Jay Pittman, Kiley Bates (Drainage District), & Nick Leblanc (Building Official for Parish) all met with Councilman Vial to require new developments coming into the parish to turn their sewer infrastructure over to the Parish instead of a private company.
