MoDAD acquisition - No recent changes.

- BOND PROJECTS Current (approved) budget = \$9,890,000 (\$8,885,000 AFC bond funds/\$1,005,000 TPSD1 funds) - NOTE ATTACHED "Sewer System Improvements -PRIORITY LIST" dated 10/16/2019:
 - System Expansion (LA445/LA22) Work has commenced; ordering pipe and related materials.
 - Lift Station Improvements [FY2017] Completed May, 2019 (contractor: DNA Underground). No additional disbursements anticipated.
 - Southeast WWTP Improvements.
 - (1) Construction by Lemoine underway.
 - (2) Concrete pours ongoing; 90% of equipment submittals approved.
 - (3) Pay Estimate #4 approved for \$535,149.16 (see item "7.b.").

- Happywoods/General Ott/Miller Mart force main manifold creating problems under review for remedies.
- Club DeLuxe Sewer Expansion Adding sewer service along Club DeLuxe Road (from Spalitta east to East Yellow Water Road).
 - Travis Lift Station site donation & engr. design complete.
 - Jason initiating acquisition of private servitudes adjacent to R/W for SS mains (both north & south sides).
