I.CALL TO ORDER: President Chairman, Brian Shirey called the meeting to order @5:00 pm.

## III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE DECEMBER 16, 2019

There was a motion made by **B.J. Couvillion** and second by **Sammy Richmond** to approve the minutes of Monday, December 16, 2019 meeting.

### IV. MANAGER'S REPORT (JASON HOOD)

Jason stated that there was a total of 82 (eighty-two) permits for December with no new addresses.

Also, a couple months ago our storage shed out at the Southeast plant storage shed was blown away. Received a check from the insurance company \$8,000.00. He requested proposal for a new storage shed from numerous venders with lowest being \$22,000.00. The shed will be a metal frame with 3 sides and an open front for storing equipment. The project should be completed weather permitting.

Jason updated the board on the Waterside Village and Woodlake Estates force main separation project Lawson Bonet as part of the maintenance contract has currently bored 4800ft of 4-inch line for Waterside Village and 1800 ft. of 6-inch force main for Woodlake Estates the total expense thus far for this project is \$159,400 of the maintenance contract pricing. There is 450 ft of each yet to be bored and the project will be finished weather permitting within 3 weeks.



Jason stated that the TSS excursions at the Northwest WWTP has been a reoccurring issue. He reached out to a chemical professional for help. The problem is that plant can not support vegetation growth which helps with the treatment process.

 BOND PROJECTS [Series 2020] – "Priority List" adopted 12/16/2019 (\$4.9 million n Series 2020 bonds) needs Engineering Report (due within 2 weeks). Status of all bond projects:

#### System Expansion (LA445/LA22)

- (1) Construction by Richard Price Contracting ongoing.
- (2) Force main work 20% complete; wet well at Champ Cooper LS installed; 2 additional wet wells being installed in next 2 weeks; total contract = 2.05% complete (as of 12/31/2019).
- (3) Pay Estimate #1 approved for \$60,149.25 (see item "6.c.").

## Southeast WWTP Improvements

- Construction by Lemoine ongoing.
- (2) Concrete work 75% complete; 95% of equip. delivered; earthwork 90% complete; total contract = 47.87% complete
- (3) Pay Estimate #7 approved for \$254,591.61 (see item "6.b.").
- (4) Changes to existing force main tie-ins being processed.

#### Bedico Regional WWTP Improvements - upgrade to 1,600,000 gpd
