I.CALL TO ORDER: President Chairman, **Brian Shirey** called the meeting to order @5:00 pm.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE JANUARY 21, 2020 MEETING.

IV. MANAGER'S REPORT (JASON HOOD)

Jason stated 133 permits were issued in January and 5 were new addresses.

Jason informed the board; he was contacted by Council woman Bridgette Hyde concerning the noise coming from the blowers at Scarlett Glen and Creekside Plant. The neighbors are complaining and are looking for a solution. Jason is looking into reducing the noise by installing insulated covers for the blowers to reduce noise.

Jason attended the last Monday Parish council meeting. It was approved that the government consultant to go to the Bond Commission and seek approval to bond out \$5.65 Million for sewerage infrastructure improvements on behalf of the Sewerage District.

Jason updated the board on new and current developments which will affect the customer base. There is a second phase added to the E. Bedico Creek development, Choctaw Ridge is under construction with 55 lots, along with the first phase of Fairhope subdivision that is 92 lots. Fireside RV Park is under construction,



Averies Way on Hwy 445 is also underway. Then in the Hammond area Covington Ridge is roughly ¾ of the way constructed with 73 lots to come. Also Coburn Lakes is in early construction of their first phase with 73 home sites in the first phase. And lastly there is a development coming to the Bankston/Crisp Rd area of Arlington Heights that will be 88 lots.

- MoDAD acquisition No recent changes.
- BOND PROJECTS [Series 2020] "Priority List" adopted 12/16/2019 (\$4.9 million in Series 2020 bonds). Status of all bond projects:
 - a. System Expansion (LA445/LA22)
 - (1) Construction by Richard Price Contracting ongoing.
 - (2) Force main work 50% complete; all 3 wet wells installed; utility conflicts on CC Road being resolved; total contract = 14.58%.
 - (3) Pay Estimate #2 approved for \$386,329.70 (see item "6.c.").
