#### a. System Expansion (LA445/LA22)

- (1) Construction by Richard Price Contracting ongoing.
- (2) Force main work 50% complete; all 3 wet wells installed; utility conflicts on CC Road caused moving the 14" FM; total contract = 20.01%.
