Jason stated he will like to start purchasing one generator per year to work toward the goal of possibly 4 generators. Jason explored the state surplus inventory. Due to Covid State surplus all done online. Will



continue to reaching out to generator suppliers for quotes in the near future. Maybe looking for authorization to purchase one this year.

And lastly the investment of subdivisions made last year on Hwy 22 and in Hammond east were significant. Including but not limited to Coburn Lakes, Covington Ridge, Choctaw Ridge and Fairhope are continuing to grow and progress.
