There was a motion made by **BJ Couvillion** and second by **James Miller** to approve minutes from the October 18, 2021 meeting.

IV. MANAGER'S REPORT (JASON HOOD)

Jason stated there was total of 155 permits with 12 of those being new addresses.

Jason updated the board on the levee work at the Brookfield WWTP stating it is 85% completed. The operations crew in conjunction with a contractor have installed the sheet piling, and that hauling the dirt into backfill the levees. Once completed Jason will update DEQ to have that treatment plant removed from the consolidated compliance order.



Jason provided the board with copy of the 2022 budget. Giving the board time to review and ask questions. The proposed 2022 budget does include a comparison between a 3% salary increase for the employee's vs a 4% increase. He asks the board to consider the cost-of-living increase, he recommended giving the 4% increase.

He told the board that the December agenda will be full with several important items for action to be taken on. Email will be sent out in advance to be reviewed. Adding in the next few weeks, Jason will receive quotes for the expansion of the Sal Mar Deb STP. To accommodate the new school TPSS will be opening at the old Harvest School on Yokum Rd. Jay Pittman has preliminary estimate of \$50,000 to do this expansion. TPSS will pay a capacity fee of \$36,000 which will put into the cost of the project.

Lastly, he informed the board on the on-going Woodlake Est. issues.
